ALSO... do what you can. This work is for everyone, but everyone works at different levels, so you can make it easier or harder to suit what you can do! Some people can write a whole paragraph, some can just say a word and ask someone to write it, what ever you can do is great!


Monday 20 th April	
Maths and English	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do.</p> <p>If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead; SHAPE of the DAY is a RECTANGLE. How many rectangles can you find in your house? Can you take a photo of them? Can you describe them Eg 'The table is made of wood, it is dark brown, it's surface is shiny' If you use a talker, can you find the word for all these rectangular items? I wonder who in our class will find the most? Put it on the school facebook if you can!</p> <p>A rectangle is a 2D shape with four straight sides and four right angles. The lengths are longer than the width however the opposite sides are the same length.</p> <p>The picture below is an example of a rectangle.</p>  <p>Rectangles are found all around us. TVs, tables, envelopes and measuring rulers can be rectangular in shape.</p>
Science and Art	<p>We are still thinking about animals... Look at CANON HALL FARM online. https://www.cannonhallfarm.co.uk/photo and look at the photos . Can you name the animals you can see? Are there any in particular that you like or don't like? Why/Why not? Which do you like best? (I love goats!). Can you make a poster about the animals you can see at Canon Hall? If you use a talker you could tell someone about them and they could write some words down for you, or you could just tell them what you can see on the photos.</p>
Independence	<p>Job of the day; HELPING MAKE A DRINK OR SNACK – can you make a different one this week? A tea or coffee or soft drink? How about toast? Do whatever</p>

	you can to help.
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Tuesday 21 st April	
Maths and English	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do.</p> <p>If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead;</p> <p>Can you draw around some rectangle shapes? Try finding different sizes. Colour them in different colours. Can you say which is the biggest, smallest?</p> <p>Can you make a picture of rectangles, maybe even make them into cars or robots or animals?</p> <p>Then, write about what you have created. <i>"I designed a robot, it has silver arms and legs and works by remote control...."</i></p>
Science and Art	<p>What is your favourite farm animal? Can you draw it or describe it on your talker? Can you label it's body parts? Use your talker to identify key words.</p>
Independence	<p>Job of the day; WIPING TABLES OR SURFACES – how good are you at this? Can you take a photo and put it on the website? Don't forget to get permission.</p>

Wednesday 22 nd April	
Maths and English	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do.</p> <p>If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead;</p> <p>Can you find some food that is in a rectangular box? Maybe some cereal? Can you design your own box of food, maybe some cakes or cereal? What flavour would they be? Design a rectangular box for them which would make people want to eat them!</p> <p>If you use a talker, can you tell someone else how to design the box? Use lots of describing words!</p>
Science and Art LET'S PRACTISE THIS EVERY WEEK!!	<p>Practise washing your hands, or get someone else to help you. You need to wash for 20 seconds. Can you count to 20 while you are washing, or can you even count backwards? Or count to 10 twice?</p> <p>Can you draw a hand or draw round someone's hand and design some jewellery eg rings, watch, bracelet for them... or even design them some nail art?</p>
Independence	<p>Job of the day; can you help with or do a job OUTSIDE eg sweeping or hanging out washing or passing the pegs?</p>

Thursday 23 rd April	
Maths and English	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do.</p> <p>If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead;</p> <p>Can you use a ruler to measure some rectangle shapes? How LONG is it? How WIDE is it? Can you measure some smaller items then draw them onto a piece of</p>

	<p>paper?</p> <p>Can you write about what you have measured (or speak using your talker), using capital letters and full stops if you can? Don't forget, do what you can, we are all different, some people can write a paragraph, some just a word!</p> <p><i>"I measured a book and it was 20cm long. I have a bigger book, that was 30 cm long and 15 cm wide."</i></p>
Science and Art	 <p>Look at this picture. Do you know what it is? It is a peacock.</p> <p>Can you find out about peacocks? Where do they live? Why do they have lovely feathers?</p> <p>Can you draw one?</p>
Independence	Job of the day; how tidy is your room? Can you do anything to help tidy it?

Friday 23 rd April	
Maths and English	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do.</p> <p>If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead; Design a book cover in a rectangle shape. Draw the rectangle carefully then think of a book cover that you would like to read. What about 'Adventures at Sea' with lots of pictures and words about sea creatures? Put your name on as the author!</p> <p>If you want you could even write a 'blurb' on another rectangle, that would be the back of the book. This is a short statement about what the book is about... " A great story all about life at sea, where a KS4 pupil makes friends with every</p>

	sea creature in Skegness!”
Science and Art	Can you design your own FARM? What animals would you put into it? You can print pictures from the internet or draw them. Which animals could you put next to each other? Would you have pigs (very smelly!), sheep, cows???
Independence	Job of the Day; can you help make your bed? Do you know how to change a pillowcase? See if you can learn!
