**SOME OF YOU** will have had work sent out to you, if you have, please continue with that.



Monday 11 <sup>th</sup> May	
Maths and English	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do. If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead;</p> <p><b>MONEY</b></p> <p>Can you find some coins and see if you can name them?</p>  <p>Can you think of some things you could buy with . Write a sentence about each one or just some words, or say something on your talker or with your voice! 50p ? eg some crisps? What flavour crisps do you like? Which would you choose? <i>I like cheese and onion crisps as they are very tangy!</i> £1 ? eg a big bar of chocolate? Mmmm... a lovely big bar of Dairy Milk? <i>I like Dairy Milk chocolate, it is very creamy.</i> You could draw a picture of what you choose to buy and describe the items.</p>
Science and Art	<p>Let's think about TREES this week. Find some pictures of trees or even take a picture of one. Draw the tree, or describe it using your talker. Can you draw what it looks like now in the SPRING time, when the leaves are just coming out? You could even make a collage picture of a tree using bits of cut up material.</p>


	 <p>How about a beautiful pink blossom tree?</p>

Maths and English	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do. If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead;</p> <p><b>MONEY</b></p> <p>Practise naming your coins again Name and match them. Collect ten 1p coins and ten 10p coins and practice counting them. Can you make a pile of coins?</p> <p>IMAGINE you have £5 to spend. What would you spend it on? Can you look in an Argos catalogue or online, find some pictures of things you could buy for £5. Cut something out and write or talk about it, try to use sentences.</p>  <p><i>This magazine costs £5. Maths and English	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do. If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead;</p> <p>Try and make amounts of money with your coins. Eg put a 10p and a 2p together, what does this make? Even if you can do this with 2p and 1p that is GREAT and Mr License said he would be very proud if you can do this!</p> <p>Ok, we are getting richer... Imagine you have £50 to spend. Choose one item or a collection that add up to £50. What would you buy? Ps4 games? Lots of colouring books? Write or say a sentence about what you would buy and why you would choose these things.</p>  <p><i>Wow look at these ear buds. These cost £50 and would give me lots of peace and quiet!</i></p>
Science and Art	<p>What sort of animals and birds live in trees? Can you see any in your garden? Take a photo or draw some birds in your tree pictures. Maybe a bird has built a nest in your tree? Or a squirrel is running up the trunk?</p>
