SOME OF YOU will have had work sent out to you, if you have, please continue with that.

ALSO... do what you can. This work is for everyone, but everyone works at different levels, so you can make it easier or harder to suit what you can do! Some people can write a whole paragraph, some can just say a word and ask someone to write it, what ever you can do is great!

Monday 18th May

Maths and English

If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do.

If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead;

MONEY

This week we will continue doing lots of practise of our money skills.

Can you find some coins and see if you can name them?



Design and write about a big bag of sweets you could buy, for yourself or someone in your family. Choose an amount of money and then decide on what sweets you would like.

	<p>would pick, then you could add up how much they might cost. Can you even design your own sweets? How much would you charge?</p> <p>When writing a word or a sentence try to use your letter formation correctly. If you can write a paragraph about your bag of sweets, remember to use capital letters and full stops.</p>
Science and Art	<p>Let's carry on thinking about TREES this week. Can you find out what this tree is called?</p>  <p>I will give you a clue, it starts with O</p> <p>Draw the tree, or describe it using your talker. Can you practise drawing these leaves from the tree?</p>  <p>Look closely at the leaves, how much detail can you add? Maybe you would like to make a painting or collage of this tree!</p>
Independence	<p>Job of the day; Initiative!</p> <p>This week we are going to try to do things without being asked to! This is an important skill for teenagers and young adults.</p> <p>Look around the room you are in. Is there anything you can do to help? Can you pick something up or tidy something away? Try doing this without being asked!</p>

Tuesday 19 th May	
Maths and English	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do. If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead;</p> <p>MONEY More practise! Practise naming your coins again Name and match them. Collect ten 1p coins and ten 10p coins and practice counting them. Can you make a pile of coins?</p> <p>IMAGINE you have £5 to spend. What would you spend it on? Can you look in an Argos catalogue or online, find some pictures of things you could buy for £5. Cut something out and write or talk about it, try to use sentences. You might even try to choose TWO or THREE things that add up to £5!</p>

Science and Art	Still thinking about trees... Find out the names of some FRUIT trees that grow in the UK. Choose one that you like and describe it, or draw it, or make a picture of it.
Independence	Job of the day; Initiative! Can you ask someone if they need anything? Offer to make them a drink, or they may even just need a joke or a hug!

Wednesday 20 th May	
Maths and English	If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do. If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead; MONEY This requires lots of practise and depends on what you can do. Practise naming your coins again. Name and match them to the correct coins. Try making amounts up to 2p and 5p or more, this will depend on how well you know your coins and everyone is different so do what you can. Eg 1p and 1p makes 2p 2p 2p and 1p makes 5p You might even try making 10p and 20p... keep trying! IMAGINE you have £10 to spend... Find TWO or more things that you could buy that ADD up to £10. Even if someone helps you with this, it is good to learn about the VALUE of things! Can you talk or write a word or even a paragraph about the things you have chosen? Why did you choose them? Do you think they are good value for money?
Science and Art LET'S PRACTISE THIS EVERY WEEK!!	Practise washing your hands, or get someone else to help you. You need to wash for 20 seconds. Can you say the ALPHABET when you are washing your hands? Or even sing it?!
Independence	Job of the day; can you help with or do a job OUTSIDE eg sweeping or hanging out washing or passing the pegs? Have you got any better at this since last time? What are you better at? What could be your next steps?

Thursday 21 st May	
Maths and English	If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do. If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead; MONEY IMAGINE you have £20 to spend. What can you buy with £20? Choose THREE

	<p>things ... find some pictures of things you could buy for £20. Cut some things out and write or talk about it, try to use sentences. If you are writing sentences try to use commas and full stops as well as remembering your capital letters. If you are using your talker, find key words by yourself and try to make a sentence!</p>
<p>Science and Art</p>	<p>Can you name this tree?</p>  <p>I will give you a clue, it starts with P</p> <p>Look closely at the leaves, draw them and see how much detail you can put</p>  <p>in to them. Did you know that the leaves are actually called NEEDLES on this tree?</p>
<p>Independence</p>	<p>Job of the day; how tidy is your bedroom? Can you do anything without being asked or told to that will help tidy it up?!</p>

<p>Maths and English</p>	<p>If you can, go on to conquer maths. Mr License has made sure there are lots of activities on here for you to do. If you don't have access to conquer maths try doing this instead;</p> <p>This is more practise from last week. Try and make amounts of money with your coins. Eg put a 10p and a 2p together, what does this make? Even if you can do this with 2p and 1p that is GREAT and Mr License said he would be very proud if you can do this!</p> <p>Ok, we are getting richer... Imagine you have £50 to spend. Choose TWO items you could buy and add them up. Even if someone helps you do this, it is important to know how much</p>
