SOME OF YOU will have had work sent out to you, if you have, please continue with that.

This week we are thinking about **FOOD!**


Each day we will think of a different foods and you can do some work that will use your Maths, English, Science and Art skills.

Do what you can. This work is for everyone, but everyone works at different levels, so you can make it easier or harder to suit what you can do! Some people can write a whole paragraph, some can just say a word and ask someone to write it, whatever you can do is great! There is something that EVERYONE can do each day.

MONDAY 8 th June	 <p>PIZZA!</p>
Maths	<p>Can you draw a large circle, or get someone to draw one for you. What shape is it? Can you divide it into half? Quarters? Eighths? These are called fractions.</p> <p>If you were to share your pizza with your family, how many pieces would you need to divide it into? 4 people = quarters, 8 people – eighths.</p>
English	<p>Describe the perfect pizza... use words or your talker or write. What toppings would you put on it? What would it taste like, smell like, feel, look like? Can you make it sound as delicious as possible... spicy, cheesy, tasty...</p>
Science	<p>Can you find out what INGREDIENTS you need to make a pizza? Find a recipe or look at the ingredients on a pizza box. What temperature do you need to cook it at? How long for? What happens to the cheese when you cook it? What happens to the toppings? How do they change?</p>
Art	<p>Design and draw your perfect pizza. You could even use collage to make a huge pizza! What would you put on it?</p> <p>Someone I know likes tuna and banana on their pizza!! YUK!</p>
Independence	<p>Do you know how to order a pizza? See if you can find out. What would you say on the phone?</p>

TUESDAY 9 th June	<p>Sandwiches!</p> 
Maths	<p>Can you find pictures of different shaped tomatoes (or draw them) – name the shapes. Triangle/rectangle/Square? You could even measure some of the sandwiches you draw, how long are they? How wide?</p> <p>See if you can find out how many sandwiches are eaten in the UK each week!</p>
English	<p>Using your voice, talker or writing, can you say a sentence, paragraph or even more all about your favourite sandwich, or the sandwich someone in your house likes?</p> <p>Could you talk about the best sandwich in the world, convince someone that your sandwich is the best. PERSUADE them ; chocolate and sprinkles sandwiches are the best because they are sweet, soft and crunchy at the same time!</p> <p>Maybe you could describe the most DISGUSTING sandwich in the world!!!!!!</p>
Science	<p>Can you think of as many SALAD items that go into a sandwich? Make a big list. Find out how these grow. Find pictures of them and make a picture like this...</p>  <p>tomato seeds tomato plants Tomatoes!</p>
Art	<p>Design and draw your best sandwich. How tall is it? How many slices of bread? What fillings are there? You could draw it or collage... using different cut up magazines? (or even the most disgusting sandwich in the world...)</p>
Independence	<p>Try and make a sandwich. Take a photo and with the permission of an adult, post it on the school website!</p>

WEDNESDAY 10 th June	 Fish and Chips!
Science	Can you find the names of as many fish as possible? I bet you can't make a list of ten... Can you find the names of fish who live in the sea around the UK?
Maths and English and Art	Make a menu for a fish and chip shop. Decide what you would put on it and how much things would cost. Can you think of realistic prices eg Fish and Chips £5? Ask someone for help if you need to. Design your menu to look attractive. If you use a talker, you can ask someone to write for you or find the words on your talker by yourself! Name your fish and chip shop!
Independence	Can you find out how to cook oven chips and even make some?

THURSDAY 11 th JUNE	 FRUIT
Science	Can you find out as many fruits as possible ? Go through the alphabet and see if you can name a fruit starting with each letter!
Maths	Do you have any fruit in your kitchen? Count them. How many bananas? How many apples? If you can, make a bar chart showing the types of fruit along the bottom and numbers along the side. 
Art	Choose a piece of fruit and draw it. See if you can match the shape and the colour.
English	Using your voice, talker or writing, can you say a sentence, paragraph or even more about why people should eat more fruit? Perhaps you could make a poster about it, you could tell people why fruit is good for you and the different types of fruit there are.
Independence	Can you prepare some fruit, eg peel a banana, or slice an apple...

FRIDAY 12 TH JUNE	CHOOSE A FOOD DAY
<p>Today, I would like you to find out about some food from a different country! Japan? Italy? Pakistan?</p> <p>Find out one dish (or more!) that you think looks nice to eat. What country does it come from? Can you find out anything about that country? When do people eat this dish? Can you find out lots of information about the country it is from?</p> <p>Can you draw or describe it or both... can you find out what ingredients are in it, how do you make it? To challenge, you could even make a recipe sheet! (or even make the dish!)</p>
