This week we are thinking about **PETS**

Each day we will think of a different **PETS** and you can do some work that will use your Maths, English, Science and Art skills.


Do what you can. This work is for everyone, but everyone works at different levels, so you can make it easier or harder to suit what you can do! Some people can write a whole paragraph, some can just say a word and ask someone to write it, whatever you can do is great! There is something that EVERYONE can do each day.

MONDAY 22nd June	 <p>Dogs</p>
Maths	<p>Conquer maths! Can you count how many dogs you see if you go for a walk? How many dogs are there in your family... who has the biggest/smallest dog? Higher challenge; find out how much dog food costs. How much would it cost to feed a 5 year old, medium sized dog for a day, week, month or even a year?</p>
English	<p>Can you say/write/draw some words, sentences or paragraphs about a dog? You could make up a story about a dog... maybe a naughty puppy or a brave rescue dog? What about an anime dog or cartoon dog... create your character and give him or her some adventures!</p>
Science	<p>Find out some science facts about dogs. Can you find out anything you didn't know before? I found out that some dogs can learn 100 words!</p>
Art	<p>Draw or make a picture of a dog, it could be one from a picture, your own pet, one from TV...</p>
Independence	<p>If you have a dog, see if you can do something to help look after it today. If you don't have a dog, do something helpful for a human in your house! Tell me all about it on our video call!</p>

TUESDAY 23rd June	<p>Cats!</p> 
Maths	<p>Conquer maths! Play this maths game online, you can choose your level... https://www.mathgames.com/play/cat-wars.html</p>
English	<p>Using your voice, talker or writing, can you say a sentence, paragraph or even more all about what you think about cats. Do you like them? Why? Why not? Can you describe a cat, what does it look, feel, sound, smell like?</p>
Science	<p>Find out some Science facts about cats. If you like big cats, find out about tigers and lions, cheetahs and leopards. Where do they live? What do they eat? If you like pet cats, find out about all the different sorts of cats there are.</p>
Art	<p>Draw or make a big picture of a cat... it might even be a huge cat like a TIGER!</p>
Independence	<p>If you have a cat, do something helpful for it today, be kind, look after it. If not, help a human instead! Tell me about what you did at our video meeting.</p>

WEDNESDAY 24 th June	<p>RABBITS</p> 
Science	<p>Find out these facts</p>

	<p>A male rabbit is called a _____</p> <p>A female rabbit is called a _____</p> <p>A baby rabbit is called a _____</p> <p>Can you find out anymore? See if anyone in your family knows the answers...</p>
Maths	<p>Go to https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ and search Rabbit takeaway to practise some simple maths skills.</p> <p>Conquer maths!</p>
English and Art	<p>Design a guide to looking after rabbits. Make it interesting, colourful... you could do it on a computer or on paper. What do you need to do to look after a rabbit? Where would it live? Can you design it a home?</p> <p>Use words, your talker, writing, to tell people on your leaflet what they need to do to look after a pet rabbit.</p>
Independence	<p>Can you think of some good things and bad things about having a pet rabbit?</p> <p>Good thing; they are cute and you can stroke them. Bad thing; you need to clean out their hutch regularly!</p>

THURSDAY 19 th JUNE	 <p>Goldfish</p>
Science	<p>Find out some facts about goldfish, maybe look at a you tube video about them... https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=CC56-1F400E</p>
Maths and English	<p>https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ and type in fishing games.</p> <p>Choose a maths or English game to play, there are all sorts of different levels.</p> <p>When you have made your picture of a goldfish, see if you can use some describing words... write or say them in as much detail as you can.</p>
Art	<p>Make a beautiful goldfish, draw it, or collage... use old magazines cut up, you could pick out all the orange shades.</p>
Independence	<p>Find out how to look after a goldfish. What would it live in? How often would it need feeding? How do you feed it?</p>

FRIDAY 19 TH JUNE	<p>CHOOSE A PET DAY</p>
<p>Today, I would like you to choose a pet animal yourself. It might be one we have already looked at or it might be something different!</p> <p>If you could pick any animal to have as a pet, what would you pick and why?</p> <p>Make a picture, design it a home, find out information, be creative and imaginative! Give it a name!</p> <p>What would it need to eat and drink? How much exercise would it need?</p> <p>How about an elephant, you could ride it to school and pick up all your friends on the way?!</p>
