This week we are thinking about **WEATHER!**

Each day we will think of a different type of WEATHER and you can do some work that will use your Maths, English, Science and Art skills.

Do what you can. This work is for everyone, but everyone works at different levels, so you can make it easier or harder to suit what you can do! Some people can write a whole paragraph, some can just say a word and ask someone to write it; whatever you can do is great! There is something that EVERYONE can do each day.

<p>MONDAY 29th June</p>	<div style="text-align: center;">   </div>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Conquer maths!</p> <p>If you collected 5mm of rain on Monday, 2mm of rain on Tuesday, 6mm of rain on Wednesday, 3mm of rain on Thursday, 10mm of rain on Friday, 1mm of rain on Saturday and 0mm of rain on Sunday.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In mm, how much did it rain all week? • Which day did it rain the most? • Which day did it rain the least? <p>Draw a graph to represent the rainfall from Monday to Sunday</p>
<p>English</p>	<p>Can you say/write/draw some words, sentences or paragraphs about A Rainy Day! You could write about a rainy adventure in the park, garden, theme park or even on another planet?</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>Find out some science facts about Rain or Flooding?</p>
<p>Art</p>	<p>Draw a rainy-day picture. You can also pick an Art Activity from the Creative Activities on the Newman School website.</p>
<p>Independence</p>	<p>Ask an adult to help clean the inside of your window so you can get a better look at the weather! Help someone in your home to clean and polish their shoes. How did it go? Explore puddles outside with a friend. Tell Mrs Turnbull all about it on your video call!</p>

<p>TUESDAY 30th June</p>	<div style="text-align: center;">   </div>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Conquer maths!</p> <p>Or maybe you could do this?</p> <p>Draw the sun using two shapes, a circle and small triangles. Colour them in, guess the total number of sides on the triangles you have used, then count the total number of sides on your triangles. How close were you?</p>
<p>English</p>	<p>Using your voice, talker or writing, can you say a sentence, paragraph or even more all about sunshine:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How it makes you feel

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What other things are the same colour as the sun?
Science	<p>Find out some Science facts about the Sun:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is it bigger or smaller than the Earth? • Why do we need the Sun? • Can you find out anymore facts?
Art	<p>Draw or make a collage of the Sun. You can also pick an Art Activity from the <i>Creative Activities</i> on the Newman School website.</p>
Independence	<p>Maybe you can help an adult make eggs, sunny side up? Or however else you like them. You could also peel an orange and share it. Remember to clean up after yourself.</p>

<p>WEDNESDAY 1st July</p>	 
Science	<p>Find out facts about Thunder and Lightning. See if anyone in your family knows the answers...</p>
Maths	<p>Go to https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ and complete a Maths activity. Conquer maths! Maths - Counting In 10s from a given number, can you count up in 10s? For example, 17 17, 27, 37, 47 For example, 234 244, 254, 264, 274.</p>
English and Art	<p>Design and draw a comic strip about a superhero with special powers. They could shoot bolts of lightning from their fingers. How do they save the World?</p>
Independence	<p>As well as exercise, we need to ensure we have a balanced diet to make sure we are fit and healthy. For one day, keep a record of what you eat and drink, including any snacks. Are you drinking enough water? Are you having five portions of fruit and vegetables? If you are snacking, are you eating crisps and biscuits or fruit? Stay safe, stay healthy</p>

<p>THURSDAY 2nd July</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Snow</p> 
<p>Science</p>	<p>Find out some facts about snow, maybe look at a YouTube video about the effects of snow? What is an avalanche?</p>
<p>Maths and English</p>	<p>If it takes 30 snowballs to make a snowman, how many snowmen can you make with 90 snowballs?</p> <p>Write a letter/card to thank a key worker for all of their hard work.</p>
<p>Art</p>	<p>Create a snowy picture, or make a snowflake using paper. You can also pick an Art Activity from the Creative Activities on the Newman School website.</p>
<p>Independence</p>	<p>Help to do a job around the house, such as washing the pots or hanging out the washing.</p>

<p>FRIDAY 3rd July</p>	<div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Today I would like you to look at different types of weather and create a news report that includes facts and pictures of your favourite ones. • You could also tell someone about your favourite kind of weather and why you like it? • You could go out with an adult and notice how beautiful nature really is. Notice the colours, sounds and smell, or you could look outside your window and describe it to someone at home.
