Science



Find out some science facts about different types of food? You could list the different properties of food?

<p>Art</p>	<p>Draw a large balloon and put a happy message in it then colour it in. You can also pick an Art Activity from the Creative Activities on the Newman School website.</p>	
<p>Independence</p>	<p>Maybe you can blow a balloon and give it to your favourite person? Could someone help you blow balloons or even bubbles?</p>

<p>Science</p>	<p>Find out facts about feeling happy and feeling sad. See if anyone in your family knows the answers...</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Go to https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ and complete a Maths activity. Conquer maths! Use 12 buttons, or paper clips or dried beans etc... Find half of the 12 things. Now find one quarter of the same group. Find one third of the whole group. Ask an adult to help you repeat with other numbers.</p>
<p>English and Art</p>	<p>Draw a picture of a birthday party and write a story about how you made a new friend playing party games. You can choose something from the Creative Activities on the Newman Website if you like?</p>
<p>Independence</p>	<p>Can you tidy up your bedroom or get someone to help you. Play a game with family members. I love playing Chess! What do you like playing?</p>

<p>Science</p>	<p>Find out some facts about how many muscles you use, in your face, to smile? How do you feel when you receive a present?</p>
<p>Maths and English</p>	<p>If you have 80 presents and you have to share them with one member of your family, how many do each of you get? Write a thank you letter to your parent/guardian for helping look after you while you've been at home.</p>
<p>Art</p>	<p>Draw each member of your household with a present, what presents have they all got? Please label your pictures. You can also pick an Art Activity from the Creative Activities on the Newman School website.</p>
